
### COMPELLING THOUGHTS.

### KNOW THE RESPONSIBILITIES..

### DEMYSTIFYING GREEN OR SUSTAINABILITY DEFINITIONS

There are a number of ways you can design and print materials in a way that considers the environment.

### DESIGN:

- Do more with less: be innovative in downsizing - go for originality rather than size, whether a retro self-folding envelope or itty-bitty business cards
- Right size it: optimise rather than oversize the job to reduce the demand for paper needed on the press
- Fill up the white space: reducing the amount of white space in a document you can reduce the amount of paper needed to produce it
- Give it a second life: Make it memorable as a resource or attractive artwork to reduce the possibility of ending up in landfill

### PAPER AND PRINTING:

 Choose chlorine free paper: request paper that has been bleached using either Totally Chlorine Free bleaching (TCF) or Process Chlorine Free bleaching (PCF)

- Check certification: several certifying bodies provide a tick of approval for paper stock from environmentally friendly sources
- Go for 'PC' recycled: use recycled paper to try to pick paper with highest percentage of recycled content available that suits your business needs
- Slim down: does it have to be on thick heavy-duty card, or can you get away with a thinner, lower GSM and still deliver a quality product?
- Request VOC-free inks: reducing the demand and choosing VOC-free alternatives can really make a difference to the amount of VOCs emitted.

There are many demands to support sustainability initiatives, especially since printing relies on natural and synthetic products, energy consumption and waste management. We have been at the forefront of sustainability for decades.
